

A LEGACY RENEWED



For more than thirty years, the Old Administration Building (OAB) at Fresno City College has been dormant, unoccupied, and unused. However, renovation and modernization have begun on this landmark, spurred by the passage of Measure E in 2002. The exterior structure has been retrofitted and upgraded for safety and compliance. Yet there is still much to be done to fully renew the legacy of the OAB before it serves the college and the community once again.


### History

The OAB began its life in 1916 as the Fresno State Normal School's first permanent structure; it was a symbol of public higher education in the San Joaquin Valley. The Spanish Renaissance building remained a focal point on campus when, in 1921, the Normal School was joined by Fresno Junior College, the state's first community college. When Fresno State Normal School—now California State University, Fresno—moved to its current location in 1956, Fresno Junior College—now Fresno City College—remained and utilized the iconic building until safety reasons forced its closure in 1976, two years after being listed on the National Register of Historic Places.






THE MORSE FAMIL
